

Rules of Entry

- Two winners will be selected in each of the categories listed below.
- Each category winner will receive a \$100 gift card.
- Winning photographs will be printed on note cards in a set of 12 note cards.
- Photographs must have been taken by student entering the contest.
- Photos that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization (removal of dust, cropping, reasonable adjustments to exposure, color and contrast, etc.) will be disqualified.
- Photographs must have been taken in Cobb County.
- Up to 3 photographs per student may be entered.
- Images must be submitted digitally, no print images will be accepted.
- Save photographs with the following naming scheme: first name_last name_category_title of photo. Ex: Maria_Garcia_water at play_creek stomp
- Please note that the format of the note cards is landscape. Photographs should be in landscape/horizontal format, or should be able to be easily cropped as such.
- Each photographic entry is subject to the free and unlicensed use by the Cobb County Water System and Cobb-Marietta Water Authority in the preparation of annual reports, planning material, website pages, social media, handouts and educational materials.
- Photographs must be a minimum of 300 dpi when 4" x 6".
