

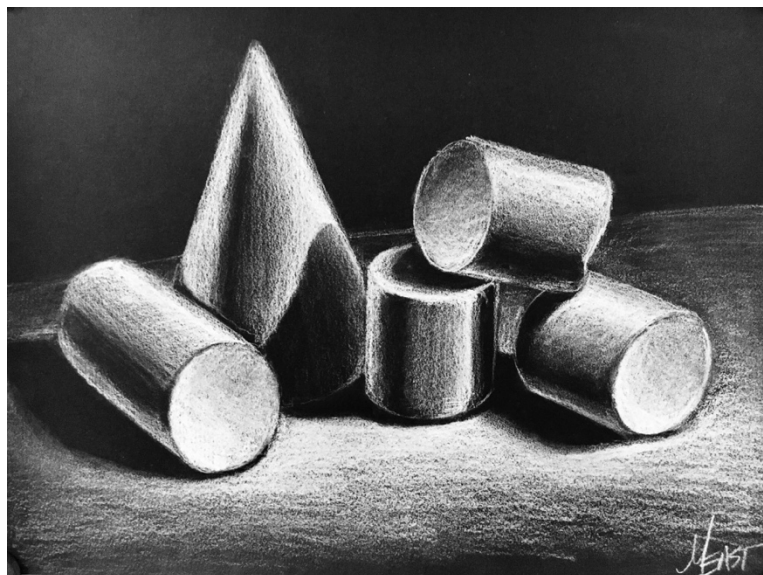


Value Drawing

-----Marshmallow Value Madness!-----

STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. Using a viewfinder, crop in on the marshmallow composition you created. Find an interesting viewpoint! (Be sure there is some overlapping of shapes, dynamic angles.)
2. Practice your composition first by creating 2 thumbnail sketches in your sketchbook.
3. Pick the best composition to draw on the larger paper, and begin drawing the contour lines within your viewfinder.
4. Once your contours are completed, begin adding the shadows with the charcoal pencils. Be sure to add very dark shadows and very light highlights.
5. You will do two 9x8 drawings, one on black paper and one on white paper.
6. When your two drawings are complete, fill out the rubric below, paperclip this paper to the drawings and turn in. (I will grade the best one.)



--Use a viewfinder to crop in on the most interesting part of the still life. (see handout)

--Use your pencil as a measuring tool to get accurate proportions. (see handout)
